Teignmouth Harbour Commission is the navigational authority responsible for the management, maintenance and improvement of the harbour.

The Commission is seeking to appoint a member with a proven knowledge of ports industry, commercial ability and experience and who will act as an independent trustee for the benefit of harbour users and the local community. Commissioner responsibilities and statutory duties arise from its status as a Trust Port.

Commissioners are required to demonstrate sound independent judgement, and to bring to the role their skills, experience and commitment for the best interests of the Commission. New members of the Commission will need to undertake training which will be provided.

The successful applicant will live within the Teignbridge area and be able to demonstrate wide knowledge and experience in the ports industry and be financially aware. Appointments to this unpaid post are made for a three year term. The Commission holds six general meetings each year.
